



## Where to get FREE or CHEAP Hangers

**Need hangers?** All clothing that you sell at Treasure Hunt Sales needs to be on hangers, either plastic, wire or wood. Here are some tried and true places in the south metro where you can find them.

### FREE:

- **Dry cleaners** (keep in mind: most clothing, even infant sizes can be hung on these wire hangers)
- Hangers that come on **new clothing**
- Ask where you shop. Some **retailers** are known for their generosity in giving away extra hangers. Try Walmart, Old Navy, Kmart, Disney Store, JC Penney, Carters/Carter Outlets, and Bon Worth. Call ahead and some stores may even save some up for you.
- Mention to your **Facebook friends** that you need hangers.
- Ask **mom**s who have children who have just outgrown the baby hangers, and are moving up to full size hangers.
- **Craigslist.org** - post a wanted ad, or search for hangers
- **Freecycle.org**
- **twincitiesfreemarket.org**
- Ask friends whose husbands get their **suits dry cleaned**.
- Ask at businesses where the employees wear **uniforms or aprons**; places like oil change/car dealerships, machine shops, coffee shops, restaurants, etc.
- As a **special perk to volunteers**, at pick-up time at the end of the sale, Treasure Hunt Sales volunteers are welcome to help themselves to any hangers we've collected throughout the sale.

The main thing is just to ASK. So many hangers just get thrown away, so you're doing everyone a favor by keeping them out of a landfill. Collect them throughout the year, and you'll have plenty when you are ready to tag.

### CHEAP:

- Walmart, Kmart, Target, and dollar stores have hangers at a reasonable price.
- If you still have trouble finding them, let us know. We sometimes have a stock of hangers for sale for \$5 for 100 hangers.
